Students interested in spending a period at the Real Conservatorio Superior de Música Victoria Eugenia in Granada in the framework of Erasmus+, are required to apply to the Erasmus Coordinator in their home institution.

*** Only Bachelor's Degree studies are offered in our Institution.**

ERASMUS STUDENTS APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Student application consists of the following forms:

- Student Application Form
- Learning Agreement (containing subjects as indicated in the Study Plans of the Guest Institution) go to "CURRICULUM"

- Transcript of Records
- Letter of motivation
- Brief Curriculum Vitae

Depending on the specialty:

- Performance and pedagogy candidates:

- Recording (mp4, DVD, link,...) of around 20 minutes.

- Composition candidates:

- Three scores, including sound recordings.

The Student Application and the Learning Agreement must be signed by the Erasmus Coordinator in the home institution.

These documents must be submitted by email.

Once our Institution has received the required documents, they will be forwarded to the correspondent department for preselecting purpose. Whether the student has been selected or not, the Erasmus Coordinator will inform the student and his/her Erasmus coordinator by email.

Acceptance of Erasmus exchange students is only possible if extra student places are available after regular applications in the same discipline have been considered.

DEADLINE:

The official deadline for applications is:

- 1st June in the case of the first semester or whole academic year mobility.
- 30th September in the case of the second semester mobility.

ACADEMIC YEAR

The dates for each academic year are to be confirmed but we indicate the following estimated dates:

Beginning of the academic year: September 20th

Beginning of the second semester: February 7th

Completion of the academic year: June 19th
